1. Remove three screws from the bottom of the Electric Option shelf using the Allen wrench supplied. Gently lift and rotate Electric Option shelf's front cover forward for access to the electrical connections. **Take special care not to scratch the inside of the cabinet when lowering the electric shelf front cover for wire access. Let cover hang from the switch wire to make the electrical connection within the shelf.**

2. Feed electric wire through access hole's plastic bushing with at minimum of 20" excess wire. Install cabinet.

3. Connect Black, White and Green to matching wiring within the junction connector.

4. Replace the Electric Option shelf front cover making sure not to crimp or pinch the switch wires and other electrical connections. Do not use any other screws other than the Allen screws supplied with the cover.

5. Insert white opal acrylic shelf on Electric Option shelf.

6. Install door. Plug Defogger tether into the nearest defogger outlet located on the bottom of the Electric Option shelf.

7. Check with power supply on-- illuminated indicator switches: Right Side -- Heated Door Defogger (blue); Left Side --Integral LED Light (white). Turn off power supply until final finishes are complete.

Rough Opening and Framing

Rough Wiring:

Rough wire for this unit should extend 20" from either the left or right wire access on the side of the cabinet to make the connections within the Electric Shelf.

Installing a Recessed & Semi-Recessed Mirrored Cabinet Electric Option

A. Determine the rough opening for the cabinet. Refer to "R.O." formula chart and diagrams on page 6. Opening must be plumb and level. Install Electric Option rough wiring with at least 20" excess wire to enable pull through from either the left of right wire access plastic bushing installed in the cabinets. This unit requires a Class A 120V



AC 20 Amp GFCI circuit breaker (Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter) required by the National Electric Code. All Electric work must be provided by a Licensed Electrician.

SPECIAL NOTE: When installing this cabinet over the finished surface that includes tile, the location of the wire access hole must be repositioned to allow for the thickness of the sheetrock and the tile.

B. Cabinet can be hinged on left or right. YOU MUST ORDER A LEFT OR RIGHT HANDED DOOR AT THE TIME OF ORDER FOR ALL MIR-RORED CABINET ELECTRIC OPTION UNITS.

For multiple cabinet units determine the hinge location for each unit before they are joined together and mark the top of each unit.

Remove the front panel of the Electric Option shelf using the Allen wrench supplied. (DO NOT LOSE THE ALLEN SCREWS PROVIDED.) (*Refer to steps 1-2 on page 5 for detailed diagrams*). Pull wire through access. Insert cabinet in R.O. and center. Cabinet flange covers any gaps in the R.O. around the cabinet and should overlap the finished surfaces--sheetrock and/or tile.

B Rough wire for this unit should extend 20" from either the left or right wire access on the side of the cabinet to make the connections within the Electric Shelf.

Hinge Plate shown for right hinged door.



THE 1 1/2" ACCESS HOLE MUST BE ALIGNED EXACTLY WITH-THE PLASTIC BUSHING TO PREVENT CRIMPING. FOR EXACT DRILL LOCATIONS FOR THE ELECTRIC ACCESS HOLE SEE DIAGRAMS ON PAGE 6

C. Install the cabinet with four (4) $\#10 \times 1 \times 1/2$ wood screws (supplied). Use the pre-punched holes above and below the hinge plates (as shown). Do not overtighten. Cover screws with four screw caps (part #434).



Electrician should make the wire con-

nections and replace the Electric Option shelf's front cover with the three Allen screws provided. Make sure not to crimp or pinch the switch wires and other electrical connections. (*Refer to steps 1-5 on pages 5 for detailed diagrams*).

TAKE CARE NOT TO SCRATCH THE INSIDE WALL OF THE CABINET WITH THE EDGES OF THE SHELF COVER.

DO NOT ALTER ANY WIRING WITH THE ELECTRIC OPTION UNIT OTHER THAN MAKING THE INITIAL CONNECTION.

Combining Two (2) or Three (3) Cabinet Units before Installation.

Any of the cabinets that are the same height may be joined to form one unit. Follow these instructions to create the final size unit before attempting installation.

For Multiple Cabinets: Two or Three unit cabinets must be joined as shown <u>before</u> installation.

Note: Three cabinet units require an additional installation screw in the top center of the center unit. Drill an access hole in the cabinet and install an additional $#10 \times 1 1/2$ " wood screw. Cover the screws with four or five screw caps (part #434).

• Be sure to determine the hinge side door swing location for each unit.

• YOU MUST ORDER A LEFT OR RIGHT HANDED DOOR AT THE TIME OF ORDER FOR ALL MIRRORED CABINET ELECTRIC OPTION UNITS.

• Mark the top of each unit-- Left, Right or Center with the Hinge plates in the proper position.

When the unit is fully assembled refer to "R.O." formula chart on page 7 to determine the R.O. required for the unit as assembled.

Assembling multiple cabinet units:

1. Place the units on a 2x4 or 2x6 stud of sufficient horizontal length to support all the units being joined. Place 4" edge of the stud flat on the floor with the cabinet facing up and the bottom flush to the inside edge of each 2x4.

2. Install the Cabinet Connector (part #426 or 429) on the outside of the left hand cabinet. Use the pre-punched holes immediately above and below the hinge plate locations. Use screws $10-32 \times 1/2$ " as supplied. (See Section #1)

3. Move the second cabinet into position so that the face flange of both units are aligned. Fix the cabinets together using screws $10-32 \times 1/2$ " as supplied. (See Section #1).

4. If there is a third unit repeat the steps above.

WARNING: Units are not intended to be interconnected electrically. Each Mirrored Cabinet with Electric Option requires its own independent connection to junction box.

Installing a Surface Mount Mirrored Cabinet Electric Option

Important:

Make sure you allow for a minimum of 1" clearance above any obstruction such as faucets, etc.



A. Determine the desired height and use a level to mark a horizontal line. Be sure to allow a minimum clearance of 1" above any obstruction and plumbing fixtures. Remember the base of the cabinet box is 3/4" smaller than the face and the door.

Side Mirror Kit Installation

For surface mounted 4" and 6" Mirrored Cabinets and 6" semirecessed Mirrored Cabinets.

1) Attach the side mirror kit brackets thru the pre-punched holes in your cabinet.

2) Try to use the first row of holes from the top and bottom of your cabinet. Using the eight $10-32 \times 1/2$ " screws fasten the brackets and finish with screw caps.

3) Attach the 2" x 2" foam pads to the outside cabinet wall above, below and in between the position of the brackets.

4) <u>Clean the backside of the side mirror kit panel with the Alco-hol pads.</u> Check alignment before you attach the mirror to be sure it will align even with the top of the cabinet.

5) Peel off paper covering of the adhesive tape on the side kit brackets pads. (*This holds the mirror in place*). Carefully align the mirror to the cabinet evenly on all four sides. Press firmly into place and attach to the side kit mirror to the cabinet body.

(Note: Once installed, do not try to remove the mirror as it will break.)

Glass Shelves Installation

After the Mirrored Cabinet box has been properly installed, determine the appropriate height and location for the glass shelves.

Note: make sure the back wall mirror has been completely cleaned after installation. If cleaning the back wall mirror is necessary, use a household non-ammonia glass cleaner.

Cleaning Recommendations:

Never use abrasive cleaners or cleaners containing ammonia. This may cause chemical damage to the mirror and void the warranty. For cleaning the mirror, we recommend using "ammonia free" Sprayway brand glass cleaner, which is available at a variety of retail outlets. www.spraywayinc.com/content/glass-cleaner

Each glass shelf will require four (4) shelf clips. Use care when handling the non-tempered glass shelves. On a level plane insert the shelf clips into the pre-punched holes. The clips are designed for a tight tension fit to hold the shelf. Place each glass shelf on the top of the left clip



first, then slowly lower onto the right clip with a snap fit.

After glass shelves are installed insert hole plugs in all open holes to complete installation.
